## BE REPRESENTED - VOTE

Wondering where to go or how to participate for this year's election? Take a look at the resources below to stay on top of it.

### Registration:

- Last day to register to vote is **Monday, October 5, 2020** (mailed applications must be postmarked by October 5, 2020)
- Last day to apply for ballot-by-mail is **Friday, October 23, 2020** (received not postmarked)

### Voting:

- Early Voting period is **Tuesday, October 13, 2020 - Friday, October 30, 2020**
- Election Day: **November 3, 2020**

### Absentee & By-Mail Voting:

All currently registered voters of Collin County are eligible to request and receive a by-mail ballot if any of the following conditions prevents them from either voting in-person during the early voting period or on election day:

- Expected absence from the County during both the early voting period and election day. The ballot must be mailed to an address outside the county.
- Disability
- 65 years of age or older
